

## COMPACTOR CHUTE RULES

To keep our building safe and compliant, certain household waste **must not** be disposed of down the chute. These items require special handling and must be disposed of properly.

### Prohibited Items:

- **Special Household Waste** such as:
  - Cigars, cigarettes, lighted matches, vape & vaping products
  - Oil-soaked rags
  - Carpet sweepings
  - Paint cans, wood stains, polishes
  - Aerosol containers
  - Automotive Waste
  - Batteries (e.g., rechargeable and button cell silver oxide batteries)
  - Fluorescent and CLF Light Bulbs
  - Medications
  - Medical Sharps (e.g., syringes, Lancets or “fingerstick”, etc.)
  - Electronic waste (e.g., TVs, computers, printers, toasters, coffee makers)

**Additional Items that need to be brought to 400/P3 Garage or 500/1<sup>st</sup> Floor Cooridor:**

- **Cat Litter**
- **Metal**
- **Wood**
- **Cardboard** (cut and broken down)

**Each resident** is responsible for arranging proper *offsite* disposal of restricted ***Special Household items*** in accordance with **Westchester County’s Disposal Process**.
