Items for Paper Recycling Bin:

- Newspaper, Magazines, Catalogues
- Mail and Greeting Cards
- Wrapping Paper
- File Folders and Office Paper
- Paper Bags
- Cardboard Egg Cartons
- Shredded Paper
- Corrugated Cardboard (small boxes, drink holders)

Medium & Large Boxes & all Bulk Items *must* be cut & broken down and taken to either the 400 P3 Garage or 500 1st Floor Service Corridor



Paper Items Down the Chute In a Trash Bag:

- Milk Cartons
- Juice Cartons
- Tissue Boxes
- Cereal Boxes
- Pizza Boxes (used)
- Frozen Food Boxes

Tips for Recycling Right!

Keep it Loose! Don't bag your recyclables except:

Place shredded paper in paper bags, not plastic bags!




All Container #'s 1 - 7, such as:

- Bottles
- Laundry Bottles

Jugs

- Lids
- Tubs
- Yogurt containers
- Plastic Cups
- Take-out containers





- Aluminum Cans
- Aluminum Foil
- Tin or Steel Cans
- Metal Lids and Metal Bottle Caps



- Glass Bottles
- Glass Jars
- Soda, Beer and Wine Bottles
- Do not recycle drinking glasses, mirror glass, ceramics, glass bakeware
- Do not put broken glass in the recycle bin

Tips for Recycling Right!

All containers are empty, rinsed and dry!

Keep it Loose ... don't bag your recyclables!

Dispose of soiled recyclables that can't be cleaned in a trash bag down the chute!
